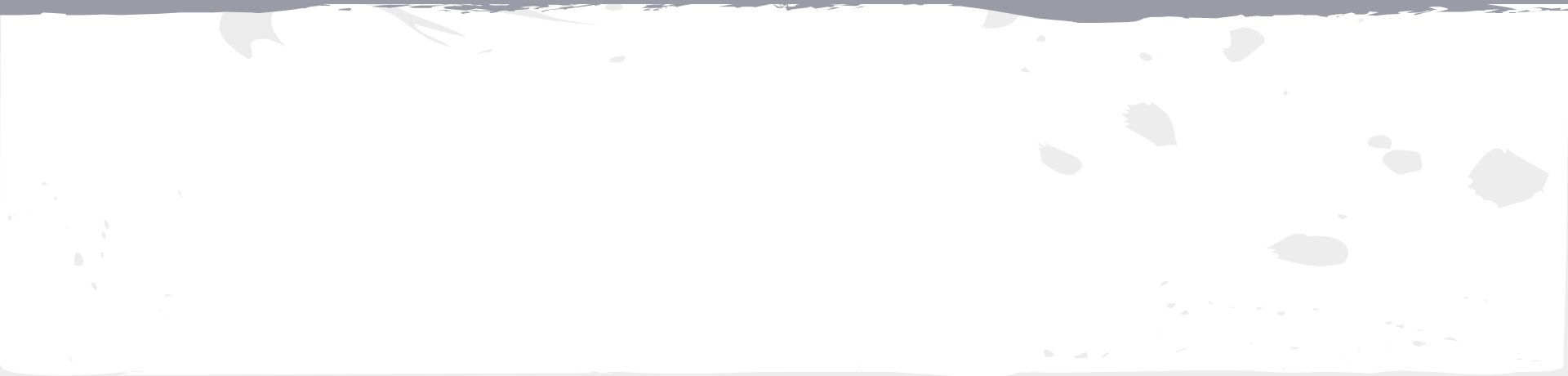

Your Character / Name

Strong's:

an appellation, as a **mark** or memorial of **individuality**; by implication honor, **authority**, **character**: - + base, [in-] fame [-ous], name (-d), **renown**, report.

Your:Soul / Character / Being

- It's you.
- It's who you are.
- It's incorporeal, intangible, non-physical

This is where people get confused.

Spirit is also incorporeal

Parable of the Talents

- Each given a specific amount.
- Each expected to give a return.
- Returning only what was given is considered wicked.



Parable of the Talents

Consider Talents = Life given to you to steward

If you return only what wasn't yours to begin with, you are certainly an **unprofitable servant** with the Master's possessions.

Poof!

As the cloud is consumed and **vanishes away**:
so he that goeth down to the grave shall come
up no more. Job 7:9

Poof!

But the wicked shall **perish**, and the enemies of YHWH shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall **consume; into smoke shall they consume away**. Psa 37:20

We all die the same.

Ecc 3:19 **For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dies, so dies the other; yea, **they have all one breath**; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is vanity.**

Perish

While I live will I praise YHWH: I will sing praises unto my Elohim **while I have any being**. Put not your trust in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help.

His **breath** goeth forth, he returns to his **earth**; in that very day his thoughts **perish**. Psa 146:2-4

Psalms 68

1Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him. 2As smoke is driven away, so drive them away: as wax melteth before the fire, so let the wicked perish at the presence of God.

Trusting Him

John 3:16 For YHWH so loved the world, that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes on him should not **perish**, but have **everlasting life**.

The Choice is Between

1. Everlasting Life
2. Perish / Death

NOT

1. Everlasting Life in the **Good Place**
2. Everlasting Life in the **Bad Place**

Didn't he die spiritually when he ate of the tree?

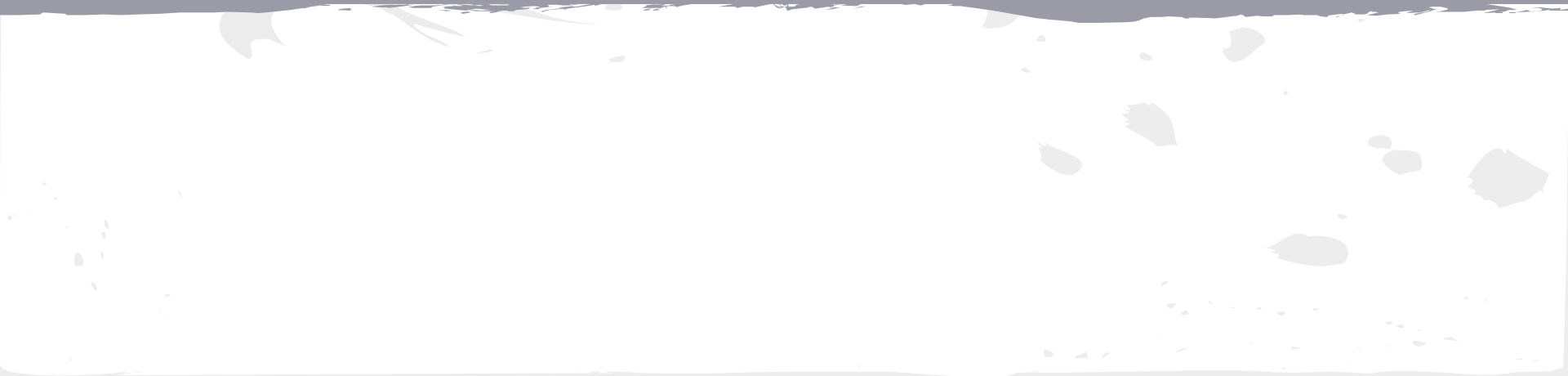

Death is like sleep

1Th 4:13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, **concerning them which are asleep**, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have **no hope**.

Asleep or Conscious?



Sleep

a condition of body and mind such as that which typically recurs for several hours every night, in which the nervous system is relatively inactive, the eyes closed, the postural muscles relaxed, and **consciousness practically suspended.** - Google “define sleep”

Conscious

- having **knowledge** of something; aware.
- painfully aware of; **sensitive** to.
- **concerned** with or **worried** about a particular matter.
- (of an **action** or **feeling**) deliberate and intentional.
- (of the mind or a thought) directly **perceptible** to and **under the control** of the person concerned.

Are the dead conscious?

Ecc 9:5-6 For the living know that they shall die: but **the dead know not any thing**, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten. Also their love, and their hatred, and their envy, is now **perished**; neither have they any more a portion for ever in any thing that is done under the sun.

Are the dead conscious?

Ecc 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for **there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave**, whither thou goest.

Are the dead conscious?

Psa 88:11 Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? or thy faithfulness in destruction?

Sleep

And why dost thou not pardon my transgression, and take away my iniquity? for now shall I **sleep in the dust**; and thou shalt seek me in the morning, but **I shall not be**.

Job 7:21

Sleep

What profit is there in my blood, when I go down to the pit? **Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth?** Psa 30:9

Where is his “soul”? What about his spirit?
Why don't they praise Him?

Job 14:10-14

But man dieth, and wasteth away: yea, man giveth up the ghost, and **where is he?** As the waters fail from the sea, and the flood decayeth and drieth up: So man lieth down, and **riseth not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.** O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and **remember me!** If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, **till my change come.**
