John 3:13 And <u>no man</u> hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even **the Son of man** which is in heaven.

"The Boy Who Came Back From Heaven"?

Alex Malarkey: "I did not die. I did not go to Heaven. When I made the claims that I did, I had never read the Bible. People have profited from lies, and continue to. They should read the Bible, which is enough."

- How do we explain some of their experiences?

DMT - Dimethyltryptamine

Elijah?

Heb 11:39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, **received not the promise**: YHWH having provided some better thing for us, that **they--without us--should not be made perfect**.

Enoch

Gen 5:23 And all the days of Enoch were **365** years, And Enoch walked with Elohim: and he was not; for Elohim took him.

Heb 11:5 By faith Enoch was **translated** that he **should not see death**; and was not found, because YHWH had **translated** him: for before his **translation** he had this testimony, that he pleased YHWH.

Translation

"...all men, wicked and righteous; and though there have been some exceptions, as Enoch and Elijah; and all will not sleep, or die, some will be found alive at Christ's appearing; yet such will undergo a change which is equivalent to death, as Enoch and Elijah have done: and generally speaking men die but once;" - J. Gill

Translation

1Cor 15:52-53 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Translation

John 3:13 And <u>no man</u> hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even **the Son of man** which is in heaven.



Hell

Hell - The Grave

- 1. Sheol (31 times as the grave)
- 2. Gehenna (12 times as place of burning)
- 3. Hades (10 times as the grave)
- 4. Tartarus (1 time as a place of darkness)

Our English word Hell

In Norse mythology, **Hel** is a **being** who presides over a **realm** of the **same name**, where she receives a portion of the dead.

Derives from Proto-Germanic *haljō, which means "**one who covers up** or **hides** something", which itself derives from Proto-Indo-European *kel-, meaning "**conceal**".

Sheol


- Righteous and Wicked both go to Sheol
- No one praises (etc) YHWH from Sheol
- A place or state of no return
- The **unseen** state

Gehenna - Gah'ee Hinnom

This was originally the valley of Hinnom, south of Jerusalem, where the filth and dead animals of the city were cast out and burned; a fit symbol of the wicked and their future destruction.

Hades

- Greek
 - Name of God of Underworld
 - Also known as [Roman] Pluto (outermost planet)
- Realm of the dead
- The grave, death, hell
- letter <u>alpha</u> + word <u>eido</u> = un-seen, not-seen



Tartarus

2Pe 2:4 For if YHWH spared not the angels that sinned, but <u>cast them down to hell</u> [tartarosas], and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Gen 6:2, Jude 1:6

Tartarus - Place and Deity

In Greek mythology it was a "place of punishment under the earth, to which, for example, the Titans were sent" (Souter).

Primordial Deities

Chaos births Primordial Deities

- Uranus (Father Sky)
- Gaia (Mother Earth)
- Chronos (Time) Serpentine, man ,lion and bull heads.
- Tartarus (Abyss)
- etc...

Titans

Primordial Deities birth Titans

- Titans are giants.
- They are offspring of the heavenly and the earthly.
- When overthrown by the new gods, they were cast into Tartarus.

Tartarus?

Jud 1:6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath **reserved in everlasting chains under darkness** unto the judgment of the great day.

Hades = Pluto = Underworld = Tartarus = Outer darkness



The Rich Man & Lazarus

Literal or Parable?

- People in "Hell" can see and talk to people in Heaven (vs 23, 24)
- They have a body's before the resurrection? (vs 23, 24)
- Abraham can resurrect Lazarus? (vs 27)

Martin Luther

Martin Luther taught that the story was a parable about rich and poor in this life and the details of the afterlife not to be taken literally.

E.W. Bullinger

It is not called a parable because it cites a notable example of the Pharisee's tradition which had been brought from Babylon.

Egyptian Parable

Some scholars suggest the basic storyline of The Rich Man and Lazarus was derived from Jewish stories that had developed from an Egyptian folktale about the journey of Si-Osiris.

Moral of the Story...

Prosperity Gospel is False

Y'shua taught contrary to the prevailing view, wealth was not an indicator of divine favor, just as poverty was not a sign of YHWH's judgement upon a person.

Moral of the Story...

Moses and the Prophets (the TaNaK) is sufficient in communicating the Good News of the Kingdom.

Prophetic Secondary Message

1 Peter 3:18-20

Spirits in Prison AKA Hell?

1Pe 3:18-19 For Messiah also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to YHWH, **being put to death** in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison;

The Answer is in the Context

1Pe 3:20 which were formerly disobedient, in the days of Noah, when the longsuffering of God commanded an ark to be made, in hope of their repentance; and eight souls only entered into it, and were kept alive in the waters.

View 1:

When Noah was building the ark, **Christ 'in spirit' was in Noah preaching repentance** and righteousness through him to unbelievers who were **on the earth then** but are now 'spirits in prison' (people in hell -- the grave).

View 2:

After Christ died, he went and preached to people in hell, offering them a second chance of salvation.

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View 3:

After Christ died, he went and preached to people in hell, proclaiming to them that he had triumphed over them and their condemnation was final.

View 4:

After **Christ died**, he **proclaimed release** to people who had repented just before they died in the flood, and led them out of their imprisonment (in **Purgatory**) into heaven.

View 5:

After Christ died (or: after he rose but before he ascended into heaven), he travelled to hell and proclaimed triumph over the fallen angels who had sinned by marrying human women before the flood.

Apostle's Creed

- 4. Suffered under Pontius Pilate; was crucified, dead and buried: **He descended into hell**:

John Gill's View

"To all the instructions and warnings which God gave them, to all the strivings of his Spirit, and to the ministry of Christ, by Noah...which seems most likely, that being the term of time in which God's longsuffering waited on them; during which time Noah was preaching to them, and building the ark."

Augustine's View

According to Augustine the spirits are the unbelieving contemporaries of Noah, to whom the spirit of Christ in Noah, preached, or to whom pre-existent Christ himself preached.

Aramaic (Syriac)

Aramaic says "souls in Sheol".

Saul & Samuel

The Transfiguration

Luke 9:29, 30; Matthew 17:1-3; Mark 9:3, 4

Where?

Mt Hermon was suggested by R. H. Fuller and John Lightfoot for two reasons: It is the highest in the area (and the Transfiguration took place on "an high mountain" (Matthew 17:1)), and it is located near Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16: 13), where the previous events reportedly took place.

Elijah is Dead

2Ki 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a **chariot** of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and EliYah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

2Ki 2:12 And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

Moses is Dead


[Deu 34:5-6]
